Section A

Answer any 6 questions. Each carry 3 marks.

1. Who were the first people from Yathrib to embrace Islam?
2. Compare the strengths and weaknesses of the Muslim and Quraysh armies in the Battle of Badr.
3. Describe the strategic location chosen by Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) for setting up the Muslim camps at Badr.
4. Discuss the controversy among Orientalists regarding the treatment of captives after Badr and how this reflects differing cultural lenses.
5. Examine the role of consultation (Shura) in deciding the positioning of the Muslim camps at Badr. How did it reflect the Prophet's leadership style?
6. Discuss the moral and ethical qualities of Prophet Muhammad that earned him the title Al-Amin.
7. Write a note on the reputation of Muhammad as "Al-Amin" in connection with Khadija's business?
8. How did the first revealed verses reflect the intellectual, moral and social transformation that Islam sought to bring in Arabia?

Section B

Answer any 4 questions. Each carry 6 marks.

9. Examine the role of the Prophet Muhammad as a leader and strategist during the Battle of Badr?
10. Analyze the preparations and strategies of both the Muslims and Quraysh in the Battle of Badr?
11. Evaluate the educational role of the captives of Badr who were asked to teach literacy as ransom.
12. Discuss the significance of the Year of the Elephant in Islamic history.

13. Evaluate the reconstruction of the Ka'bah as a turning point in the life of the Prophet before his prophethood.
14. Evaluate the marriages of the Prophet's daughters (Ruqayyah, Umm Kulthum, Fathimah) in shaping the political, social, and religious alliances of early Islam?

Section C

Answer any 2 questions. Each carry 14 marks.

15. Discuss the political, social, and religious advantages gained by Muslims after the Treaty of Hudaibiyah.
16. Evaluate the impact of the treaty on Muslim-Quraysh relations leading up to the conquest of Makkah.
17. Critically assess the relationship between the Ansar and the Muhajirun after the Migration to Medina and explain how this unity contributed to the success of the Islamic mission.
